

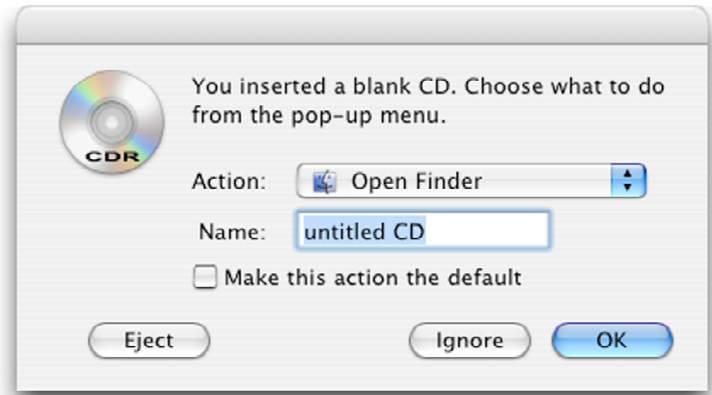
CD-Burning in Macintosh OS X

Burning files to a CD is, at heart, a simple process. Insert a CD, give the CD a name, drag the stuff you want to burn onto that CD's icon, then tell the Mac to burn the CD. Done! Easy, right? Here are the steps in detail:

1. Insert a CD into the CD-RW drive.

This window will pop up:

Type in a name for your CD and click the "OK" button..



2. A new icon will appear on the side of the screen like this:
Whenever you have a file for the CD, drag it onto this icon.

3. When you are ready to burn the CD, click once on this icon to highlight it, then choose "Burn Disc..." under the File menu.
