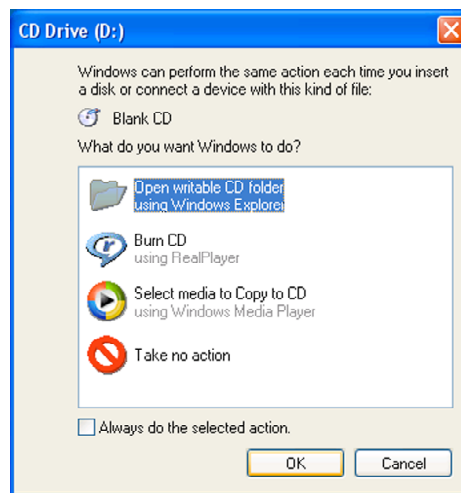


CD-Burning in Window XP

Burning files to a CD is, at heart, a simple process. Insert a CD, tell Windows you want a folder for stuff to burn, put the stuff you want to burn into that folder, then tell Windows to burn the CD. Done! Easy, right? Here are the steps in detail:

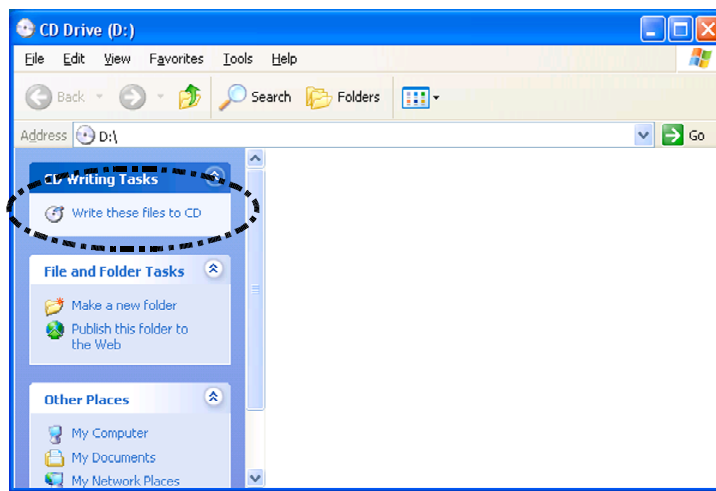
1. Insert a CD into the CD-RW drive. Your CD should be rated at 40X or higher. This window will pop up:

The "Open writeable CD..." option should be highlighted. Just click the "OK" button.



2. This window will open next. Just minimize it. Whenever you have a file for the CD, drop it into this folder.

3. When you are ready to burn the CD, open this window and click "Write these files to CD."



4. The CD Writing Wizard will open next, just follow its instructions.
