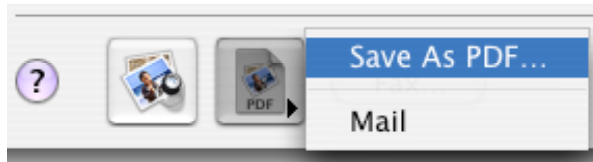


Printing to PDF

What is PDF? PDF stands for “PostScript Document file.” A PDF can be opened and read by any computer that has the free program “Acrobat Reader” installed. If your computer doesn't have this, go to www.adobe.com and download it. If you “print to PDF” you will get a file you can save to disk and read or print somewhere else or email to someone instead of printing the file on paper and paying for it.

For Macintosh OS X, follow these instructions:

1. Choose “Print...” under the File menu.
2. Click on the PDF button then on “**Save as PDF...**”

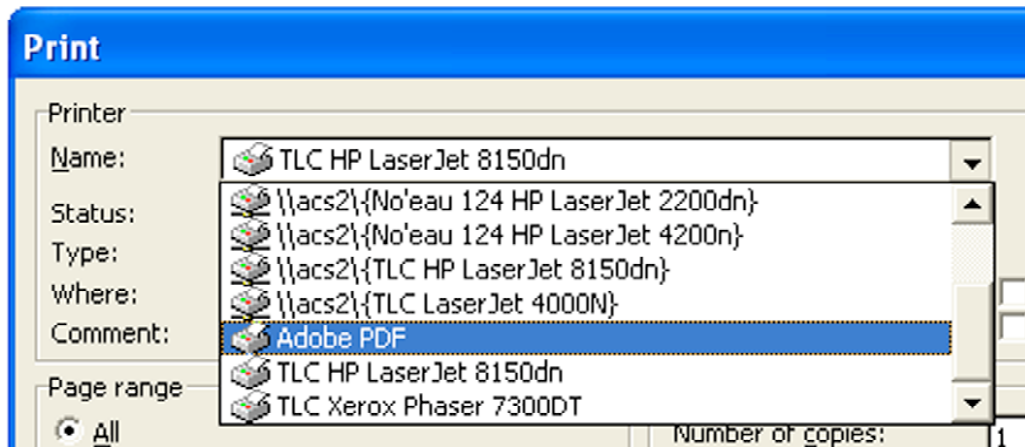


3. Give the file a name and change “Where” to “Desktop”.
4. Click the “Save” button.



For Windows, follow these instructions:

1. Choose “Print...” under the File menu.
2. Change the printer to Adobe PDF (WinXP) or Adobe Distiller (Win98):



3. Click on “Save.” Give the file a name (make sure it ends in *.pdf*) and change “Where” to “Desktop”.
4. Click the “Save” button
